

Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund



The Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund of Coastal Community Foundation awards grants annually to nonprofit organizations serving Berkeley County. With recommendation from their professional advisor, an anonymous couple established this endowed fund in 2008 with the purpose of improving the quality of life in Berkeley County. Ray Smith, the couple's advisor, said the partnership with CCF was "a perfect fit as it allowed the couple to quietly help a multitude of nonprofit organizations without the responsibility of serving in an advisory role." Since its inception, others have added their support and the fund has awarded over \$600,000 to nonprofits serving the county.



Community Impact: FEEDING OF THE MULTITUDES

One local organization that has benefited from support from the Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund is **Feeding of the Multitudes**. Feeding of the Multitudes works to improve the health and well-being of needy persons and families in the Cainhoy, Huger/Wando and surrounding areas by providing nutritious food.

With funds from the Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund, the organization was able to obtain a refrigerator truck and secure a permanent location with refrigeration facilities to serve as an emergency food pantry. Feeding of the Multitudes volunteer Maureen Cannon remarked that these grant funds helped to build "a coalition of support in the community" so that they could meet their organizational goals.

THE REASON FOR THE SEASON

Local utility company, Santee Cooper, has been a long-time supporter of the fund. Their holiday fundraiser, Celebrate The Season, raises funds for not only the Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund, but also for five additional nonprofits serving Berkeley County. Celebrate the Season is comprised of holiday events including Holiday Fairs, the Tinsel Trot, and their most popular



event, the Holiday Lights Driving Tour. "Santee Cooper and our team members are proud to be able to give back to our community, and it's especially rewarding to help raise money for the Coastal Community Foundation's Giving Back to Berkeley County Fund, which helps lend a hand to people living right here in Berkeley County," said Jimmy Staton, Santee Cooper President and CEO.
