

The Beaufort Fund



he Beaufort Fund, the largest-ever grantmaking program of Coastal Community Foundation, has awarded grants to nonprofits serving Beaufort, Jasper, Hampton and Colleton counties since 1999. Over the past 24 years, The Beaufort Fund has awarded more than \$12 million to support more than 200 local nonprofits.

Until spring of 2022, almost nobody knew who created this generous resource for the community. The couple who established The Beaufort Fund, Joanne and Alan Moses, wished to remain anonymous until their deaths to ensure the focus always remained on the nonprofits doing the "real work." This couple from Dataw Island, Beaufort, were unassuming people who viewed the wealth they accrued late in life as a mere stroke of luck. To them, it only made sense to give as much of it away as they could to support meaningful causes such as improving education and access to healthcare, among many others.



Upon retirement, Joanne and Alan left New Jersey and headed straight for Dataw Island (Beaufort County), an area they had fallen in love with while on a vacation years earlier. "After they retired and moved down to Beaufort, they really loved the area, but they also saw a lot of people who needed help," said their son Bill Moses. "They really wanted to help people, and it gave them no end of pleasure to see people benefiting from what they had done. The more

they were able to accomplish, the happier it made them."


In many ways, said Bill, they demonstrated that ordinary people can do extraordinary things. "They were very cognizant of the fact that they lived the life they did as adults due to the generosity of others, and they felt it was their duty to create such opportunities for those coming behind them," said their daughter, Anne McCaffrey.

In addition to funding The Beaufort Fund, Joanne and Alan also served on the advisory committee that reviewed applications, conducted site visits, and developed award recommendations. We are forever grateful to Joanne and Alan's philanthropy – this region is certainly better because of them.


